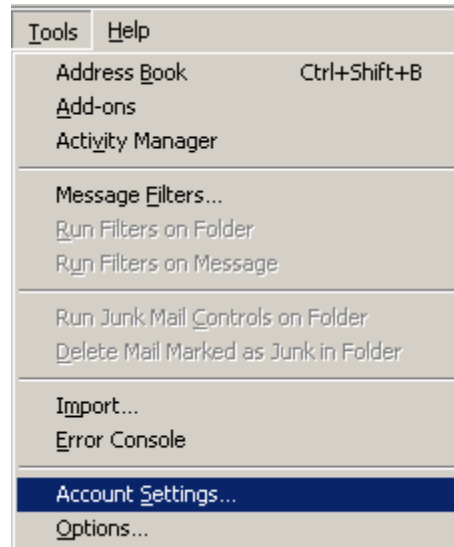
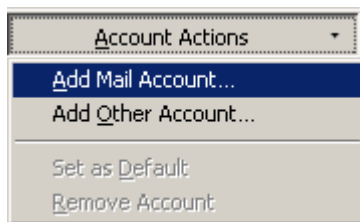


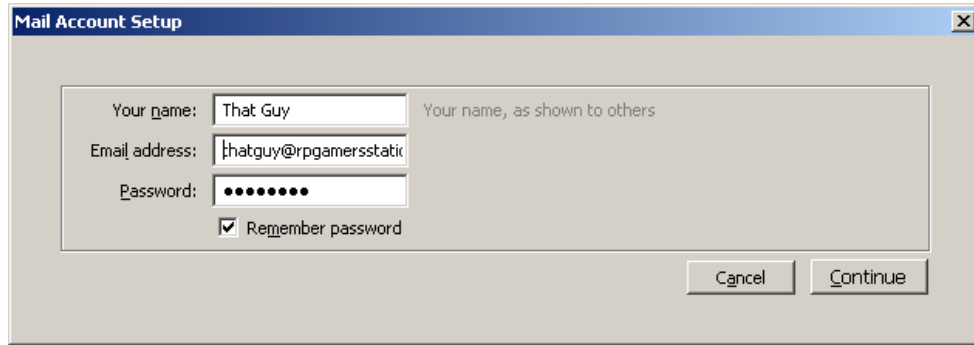
- ❖ Account Settings:

 - "Accounts"



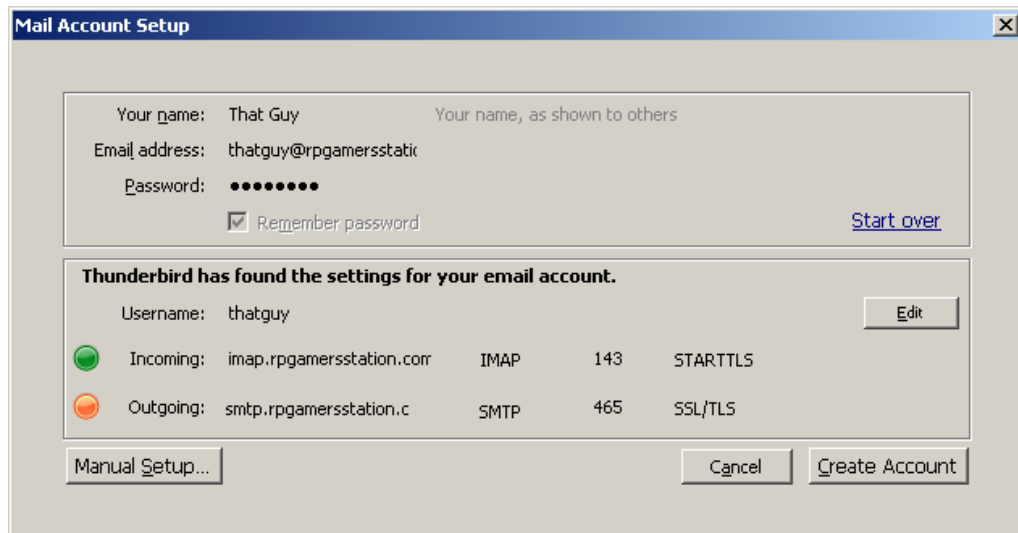
- ❖ Add Mail account

- ❖ Mail Account Setup
 - Enter
 - Name
 - Email Address
 - Password
 - Click
 - Continue



- Thunderbird will attempt to automatically detect the correct settings...it may fail.
 - After it goes through its cycle, click "Edit"



- Enter in correct information
 - Username (entire email address)
 - Incoming mail server
 - **pop.bluetie.com** or **imap.bluetie.com**
 - select POP in the drop down (or IMAP)
 - Port: **110** (POP) 143 (IMAP)
 - Security
 - ◆ None
 - ◆ If you want to use SSL, you can select it.
 - Outgoing mail server
 - **smtp.bluetie.com**
 - Port: **5125**
 - Security
 - None (if you don't want to use SSL)
