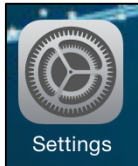
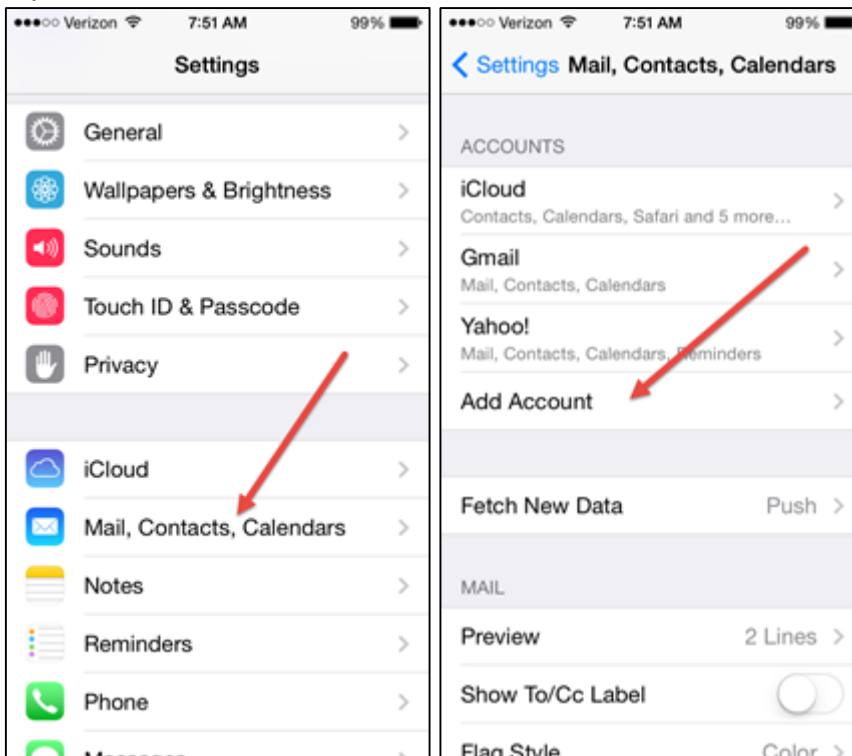


iPhone Email Setup (iPhone 5 – iOS 7.1.2)

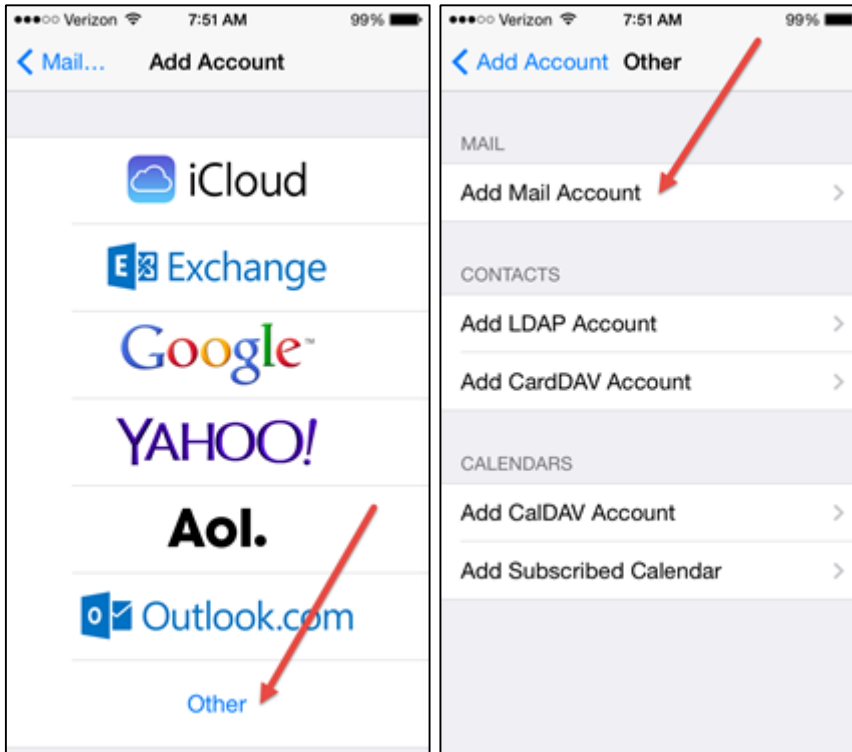
1. Tap the **Settings** icon



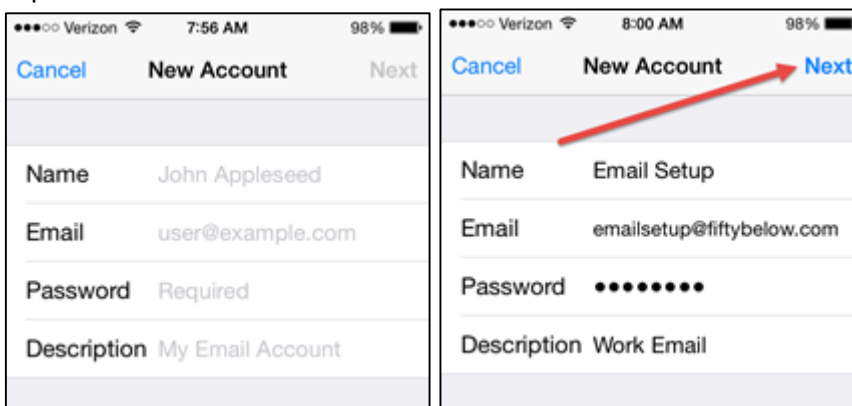
2. In Settings, tap **Mail, Contacts, Calendars**
3. Tap **Add Account**



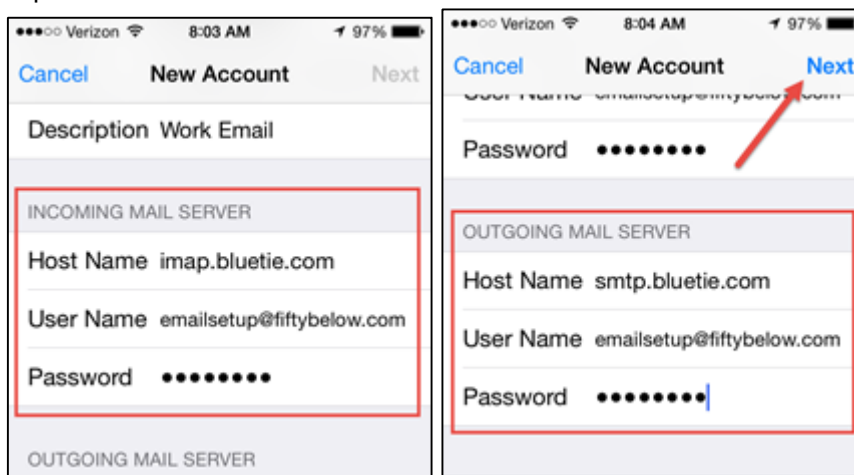
4. Tap on the option for **Other**
5. Choose **Add Mail Account**



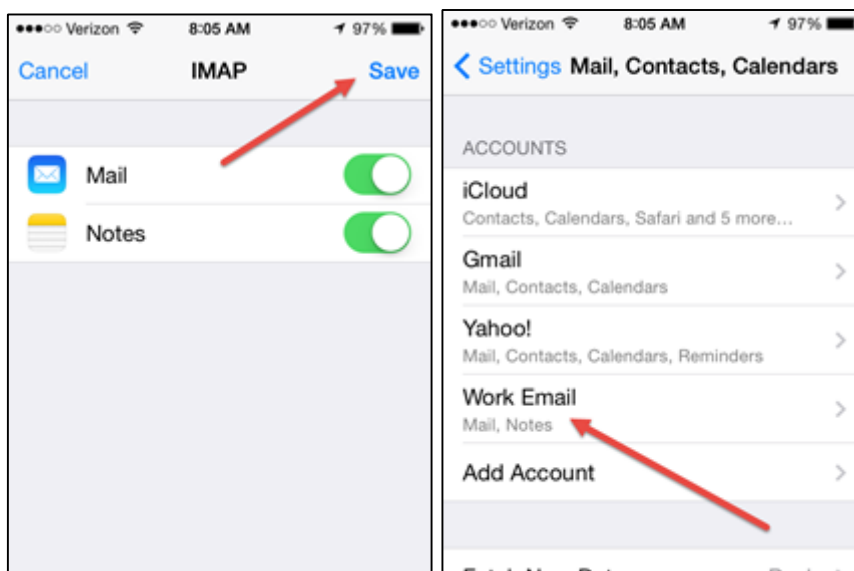
6. Enter the following details:
 - a. Your Name – Your Name as you wish it to appear in the “From” field
 - b. Email – Your **full** email address (Example: me@domain.com)
 - c. Password – The same password that you use to access the email through webmail or an email program on your computer
 - d. Description – The text you this account labeled with for finding it on your phone. Other people will not see this description in any emails that you send.
7. Tap **Next**



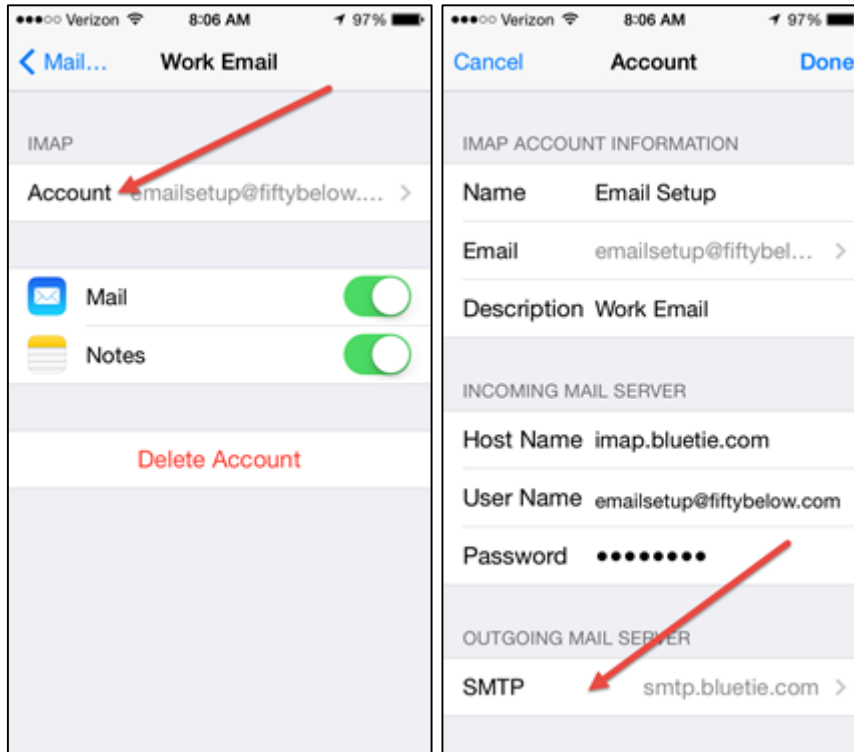
8. Leave the selection of IMAP as is
9. Scroll down to **Incoming Mail Server** section. Enter the following information:
 - a. Host Name – imap.bluetie.com
 - b. Username – Your **full** email address (Example: me@domain.com)
 - c. Password – The same as you entered on the previous screen
10. Scroll down to the **Outgoing Mail Server** section. Enter the following information:
 - a. Host Name – smtp.bluetie.com
 - b. Username – Your **full** email address (Example: me@domain.com)
 - c. Password – The same as you entered on the previous screen
11. Tap **Next**



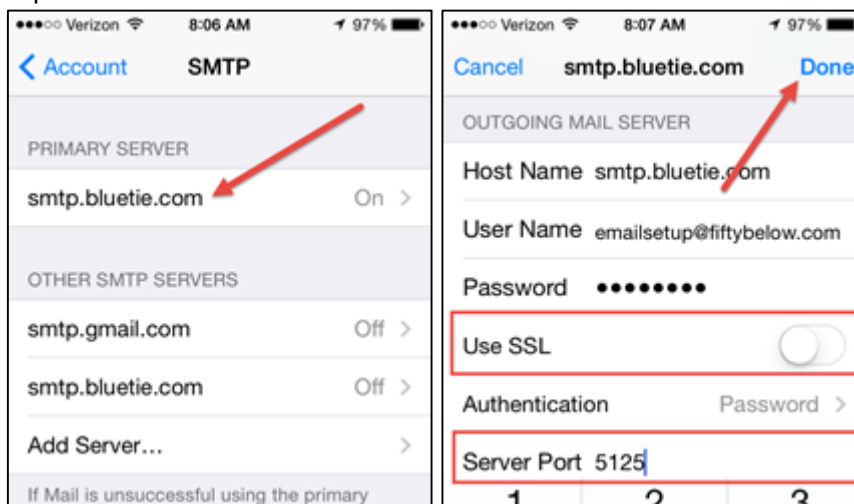
12. Tap **Save**
13. You will be taken back to the main accounts screen. Tap on the **line for the account you just added**.



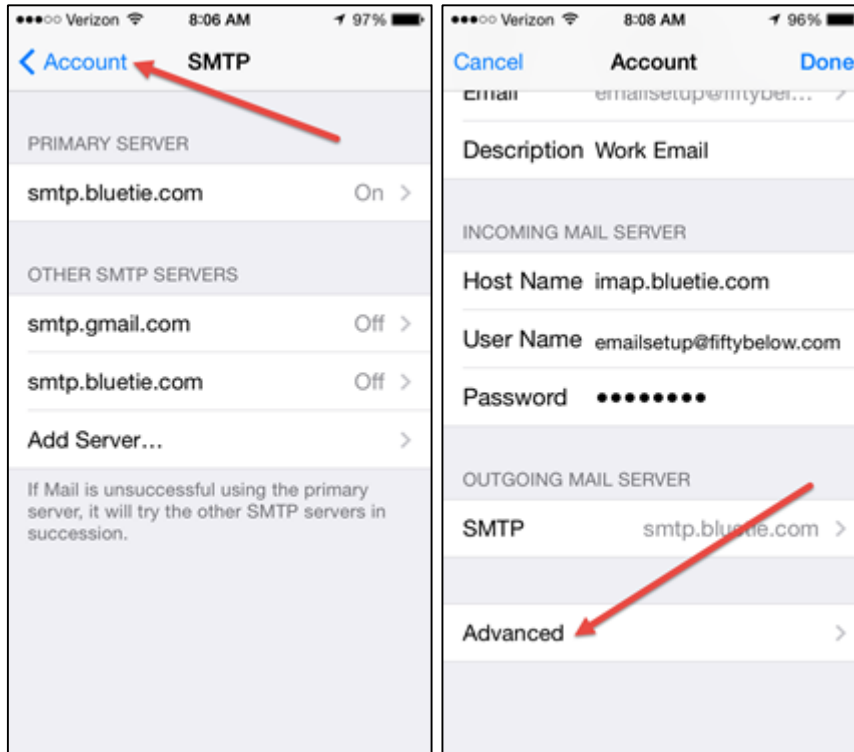
14. Tap on the **Account** line
15. Tap on the **SMTP** line in the Outgoing Mail Server area



16. Tap on the **smtp.bluetie.com** line
17. Make sure the SSL is **off**
18. Update the **Server Port** number to 5125
19. Tap **Done**



20. Tap the < **Account** option
21. Tap on the **Advanced** line



22. In the **Incoming Settings** area, make sure that SSL is **off**
23. Confirm that the **Server Port** is 143
24. Tap on < **Account**
25. Tap **Done**
